8	(a) For all necessary purposes, commence, maintain or defend actions and other	
9	legal proceedings as a personal representative.	
10	(b) Without prior order of the court, sell any perishable property of the estate, as provided in <u>NRS 148.170</u> .	
11	(c) Exercise such other powers as have been conferred by the order of	
12	appointment.	
13	(d) Obtain leave of the court to borrow money or to lease or mortgage real property in the same manner as an executor or administrator.
