WHEREAS, Rule 1.30(b) of the Rules of Practice for the Eighth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada ("EDCR") charges the Chief Judge of the Eighth Judicial District Court with various responsibilities, such as supervising the administrative business of the Court, ensuring the quality and continuity of its services, supervising its calendar, reassigning cases as convenience or necessity requires, assuring the court's duties are timely and orderly performed, and otherwise facilitating the business of the Court;

WHEREAS, hearing masters perform an integral function in carrying out the Court's responsibility to efficiently manage its docket, and the Court routinely relies on the invaluable services provided by such hearing masters to conduct various proceedings in order to facilitate the expeditious resolution of cases; and,

WHEREAS, providing cross-training opportunities for existing hearing masters will render them more versatile and will give the Court additional flexibility prospectively in fashioning hearing master assignments as caseload needs and demands tend to vary over time.
