WHEREAS, Rule 1.30(b) of the Rules of Practice for the Eighth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada (“EDCR”) charges the Chief Judge of the Eighth Judicial District Court (“EJDC”) with various responsibilities, such as supervising the administrative business of the EJDC, ensuring the quality and continuity of its services, supervising its calendar, reassigning cases as convenience or necessity requires, assuring the court’s duties are timely and orderly performed, and otherwise facilitating the business of the EJDC; and,

WHEREAS, probate and adult guardianship case filings have increased significantly over the years, and EJDC leadership intends to examine the current business practices employed in the adjudication of its probate and adult guardianship caseload for the purpose of improving efficiency in the management and disposition of such cases.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(b), that a Probate/Adult Guardianship Committee shall be formed consisting of Chief Judge-elect Linda Bell, Judge Joanna Kishner, Judge Gloria Sturman, Judge Vincent Ochoa, Judge William Potter, James Berchtold, Elizabeth Brickfield, Christy Brad Escobar, Dara Goldsmith, and other such individuals as may be appointed by the Chief Judge.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Committee shall examine existing business practices in probate and adult guardianship cases, compare those practices to current national best practices, examine applicable court rules and propose any necessary rule changes, identify whether EJDC human capital resources are sufficient to process existing caseloads, identify viable operational and technological improvements, and examine any other matters relevant to the efficient adjudication of probate and adult guardianship cases.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Committee shall, upon concluding its examination, report any recommended changes to the existing process, if any, to the Chief Judge.
