Assignment of Civil Cases Among)
Commissioners Hearing Discovery Matters)

IN THE MATTER OF

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER: 12-06

WHEREAS pursuant to Administrative Orders 10-03 and 10-12 the assignment of discovery matters for certain departments was made between Commissioner Bonnie Bulla and Commissioner Chris Beecroft;

WHEREAS the Eighth Judicial District Court has received two new judges who began adjudicating cases in the Civil/Criminal Division; and,

WHEREAS redistribution of the existing cases in the Eighth Judicial District Court Civil/Criminal Division was required to ensure equitable caseloads among all its judges; and,

WHEREAS the redistribution of these existing cases requires a reallocation of the responsibility for discovery matters for certain departments between Commissioner Bonnie Bulla and Commissioner Chris Beecroft;

NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Administrative Orders 10-03 and 10-12 remain in effect but certain departmental assignments are modified as identified herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Commissioner Bonnie Bulla shall continue to perform all of the functions outlined in EDCR 2.55(b).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Commissioner Bonnie Bulla shall be assigned to hear discovery matters originating from the following District Court Departments: 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 13, 15, 16, 18, 19, 20, 22, 23, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 and 32 filed or submitted on or after August 13, 2012.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Commissioner Chris Beecroft shall be assigned to hear discovery matters originating from the following District Court Departments: 4, 8, 12, 14, 17, 21, 24 and 31 filed or submitted on or after August 13, 2012.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if one of the Commissioners hearing Discovery matters is disqualified or recuses from consideration of a particular case that the discovery matters in that case will be heard by the other Commissioner hearing discovery matters.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order will not affect: (1) cases assigned to a business court docket; (2) cases in which a District Court Judge has designated the matter as complex pursuant to NRCP 16.1(f); or (3) cases in which a District Court Judge has otherwise assumed the responsibility for handling discovery matters.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order shall be in effect on August 13, 2012 and shall continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent Administrative Order.
