Administrative Order 12-09

WHEREAS access to justice for victims of child abuse and neglect is an essential function and a priority for the Eighth Judicial District Court; and,

WHEREAS the Chief Judge has identified various issues potentially impacting access to justice in juvenile dependency matters; and,

WHEREAS in order to provide the most efficient service and access to justice to the dependency population, the entire dependency system should be examined from referral, to case management/representation, to adjudication, to treatment and permanent placement; and,

WHEREAS the Eighth Judicial District Court stands committed to this examination and change when necessary; and,

WHEREAS the establishment of a court-led special committee to examine this issue is in the best interest of the community; and,

WHEREAS Rule 1.30(b)(16) of the Eighth Judicial District Court Rules ("EDCR") allows the Chief Judge to appoint standing and special committees of judges as may be advisable to assist in the proper performance of the duties and functions of the court:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, pursuant to EDCR 1.30 (b)(16), a special committee is hereby established to examine access to justice in the Dependency Court of the Eighth Judicial District Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Judges Robert Teuton, Frank Sullivan, Charles Hoskin, and Arthur Ritchie Jr. be appointed to this committee.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the committee examine issues of court rules, court case management, case assignment, whether case processing delays are related to hearing master resources and duties as defined in EDCR 1.46, timeliness of trials and

hearings, judicial resources, statistics and their definitions, statutory timelines, trial stacks, and any other matters relating hereto.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Arthur Ritchie Jr. be appointed as chairperson of this committee. The committee must hold its initial meeting by December 14, 2012. The chairperson shall be responsible for the agenda, coordinating staff assignments through the Court Executive Officer, and preparing reports of findings and recommendations. The chairperson shall invite all community partners to participate in the committee discussion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, after having thoroughly examined current management practices in the juvenile dependency program and identifying the potential improvements thereto, the committee shall submit a report and recommendation for the Chief Judge to consider. If during the course of its examination the committee discovers a deficiency in the program that it regards as critical, the committee shall notify the Chief Judge forthwith and present suggestions for improvement, if any.
