

EIGHTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT MAT- RE-ENTRY TREATMENT COURT

Presiding Judge: Hearing Master Claudia Romney

Purpose:

The MAT Re-entry Court is a court supervised treatment program for individuals on parole with substance abuse, co-occurring and/or mental health needs. The program offers substance abuse counseling, random drug/alcohol testing and court supervision of program compliance. Successful completion of the program will result in the individual obtaining stable housing, employment, and medical care.

Services and Treatment Include:

- Regular random drug testing (urine tests)
- Individual and group substance abuse counseling
- Mental health and co-occurring counseling
- Collaborative case management
- Community supervision
- Medical for Addiction Treatment
- Regular court status check reviews
- Transitional Housing with Case Management

Eligibility:

- Eligible for parole, have a minimum of 9 months supervision time once released,-OR-the offender is within 2 years of his/hers probably release from prison per NRS 209.4886,
- Identified opioid use disorder diagnosis and/or stimulant use disorder (can be in addition to other alcohol and substance use disorders)
- No sexual offenses, past or present, and
- All violent, trafficking/sales, and arson cases will be staffed on a case by case basis.

Cost: The program costs for housing and treatment (time period 6 months) and testing are paid by the court. Ancillary services or sanctions may require additional fees to be paid by the participant.

Length: Minimal program participation preferred is one (1) year and duration is typically until the

participant reaches his/her parole date.
