Purpose:

Family Treatment Court is a court supervised outpatient substance abuse treatment program for alcohol and drug dependent parents involved in the child welfare system.

Treatment Includes:

- Regular random drug testing (urine tests),
- Individual and group substance abuse,
- Mental health counseling,
- Parenting classes,
- Wellness education,¹ and
- Regular court reviews.

Eligibility:

- Parent must have open and formal case with DFS
- Children are out-of-home (some in-home cases accepted)
- Parent meets diagnostic criteria for an alcohol/substance dependency
- DFS case must remain open until client completes the program
- Client must agree to and sign Family Drug Court Contract (found in UNITY)

Cost: Clark County Specialty Courts pays for the treatment and drug testing costs. Choices provides bus passes for transportation to treatment. DFS pays for the initial assessment unless covered by parent's insurance.

Length: Average program length is 10 to 12 months
