Purpose:

The Clark County Juvenile Drug Court (JDTC) mission is to reduce substance use and delinquency rates by Clark County teens. The JDTC utilizes therapeutic interventions, judicial supervision of programming and random drug and alcohol testing of participants to address alcohol and drug use among teens in the program.

The short-term and long-term objectives of the program are to improve the mental and physical health of JDTC participants, address the dynamics of participant family units, and increase the community's safety by reducing delinquency rates of participants.

Treatment Includes:

- Drug testing
- Individual and group counseling provided (Co-occurring, Substance Abuse, and Family)
- Collaborative case management
- Pro-active and support groups
- Community supervision
- Electronic monitoring and/or additional substance use monitoring tools
- Regular court status reviews

Eligibility:

- 14-17 years of age at time of the referral (exceptions will be staffed on a case by case bases)
- Identified alcohol/substance abuse disorder based on DSM-5 criteria
- Youth Level of Service/Case Management Inventory (YLS/CMI) score is medium/moderate to high

Cost:

Treatment and testing fees are paid by the Court. Ancillary services or sanctions may require additional fees to be paid by participant

Length:

The program length is based on length of abstinence, court compliance, and clinical progression (with a goal of program completion within 6-12 months)

Treatment provider Healthy Minds

Please send the referrals directly to STEPCourt@clarkcountycourts.us and the coordinator will screen the youth for substance abuse, mental health, and level of care. Recommendations will be sent to the referring entity, JDTC Probation officer, District Attorney, Defense Counsel and the judicial department.
