

Specialty Courts Breakdown

Adult Drug Court (minimum 18-month program)

- o Identified substance use disorder (can have low-to-moderate mental health needs as well)
- All history of violent offenses or drug trafficking will be staffed on an individual basis
- No history of sex offenses

• Co-Occurring Disorders Court (minimum 18-month program)

- o Identified mental health and substance use disorder (must have both)
- Clients must be able to establish independent housing within four months of starting the program
- o Applications must include medical records documenting mental health diagnosis/es

• Felony DUI (3-5-year program)

- o Minimum of three DUI charges within a seven year period
- o Identified substance use disorder
- Applicants with any previous felony DUI convictions or those who have previously participated in the program will not be eligible

• MAT Re-Entry Treatment Court (minimum 6-month program)

- o For individuals on parole or inmates within 2 years of release
- o Individuals on parole must have minimum of 6 months remaining on parole
- o Identified opiate and/or stimulant use disorder
- Additional mental health and substance abuse needs can be treated
- o All history of violent, trafficking/sales, and arson cases will be staffed on a case-by-case basis
- No history of sex offenses

• Mental Health Court (minimum 15-month program)

- Identified serious mental health disorder (can have substance use disorders as well)
- o All cases will be staffed individually- no automatic disqualifying factors
- Applications must include medical records documenting mental health diagnosis/es

• OPEN Program (one-year program)

- o 18-26 year olds only
- o Intended for those who need additional assistance complying with rules of probation
- o Limited substance abuse and mental health needs (staffed on a case-by-case basis)
- No history of sex offenses

• TAP (18-month program)

- o 18-25.5 years olds only
- Identified substance use disorder
- No history of violent offenses or drug trafficking
- No history of sex offenses

• Veteran's Treatment Court (18-month program)

- Veterans or members of the US Military only
- o Must qualify for services through the VA
- o Must have service-related substance abuse or mental health issue
- No history of sex offenses
