## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING BUSINESS COURT

WHEREAS, the Eighth Judicial District Court Rule 1.33 (b) provides that the Chief Judge must assign Judges of the District to the Business Court Division;

**WHEREAS**, the Eighth Judicial District Court Rule 1.61 provides for the assignment of Business Matters;

WHEREAS, Judge Kathleen Delaney has completed her assignment to Specialty Courts; and,

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge and the Presiding Judge of the Civil Division of the Eighth Judicial District Court have selected Judge Nancy L. Allf as a fifth Business Court Judge, reassigned Kathleen Delaney to resume hearing Business Matters, joining Judges, Mark Denton, Elizabeth Gonzalez, and Susan Scann as the District Judges to hear Business Court matters pursuant to EDCR 1.33 and EDCR 1.61.

Therefore,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Administrative Order 2011- 03 is hereby amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Honorable Nancy L Allf of Department XXVII and the Honorable Kathleen Delaney of Department XXV are hereby designated to serve as Business Court Judges for the Eighth Judicial District Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Judge Nancy L. Allf, Department XXVII, Judge Kathleen Delaney, Department XXV, Judge Mark Denton, Department XIII, Judge Elizabeth Gonzalez, Department XI, and Judge Susan Scann, Department XXIX, shall be the District Judges assigned Business Court matters for the Eighth Judicial District Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, Judge Allan R Earl, Department XIX, has been selected to act as a Conflict Business Court Judge in those instances where the other Judges have been peremptorily challenged or otherwise recuse.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the new business court filings effective January 22, 2013 or after shall be assigned randomly, 1/4 to Department XI, 1/4 to Department XIII, 1/8 to Department XXV, 1/8 to Department XXVII and 1/4 to Department XXIX to hear the Business Court docket. If one of the Business Court Judges named above is peremptorily challenged or otherwise recuses, the case shall be assigned to one of the other Business Court Judges. In those instances where all of the Business Court Judges have been peremptorily challenged or otherwise recuse, then the case shall be assigned to the Judge(s) assigned to preside over Business Court cases on a Conflict Basis. In those instances where all such Judges have been peremptorily challenged or otherwise recuse, then the case shall be assigned to the Chief Judge of the District Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order shall issue *nunc pro tunc*, be deemed to have taken effect on January 22, 2013, and shall continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent Administrative Order.
