Administrative Order: 15-03

WHEREAS Rule 1.30 of the Rules of Practice for the Eighth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada (“EDCR”) charges the Chief Judge of the Eighth Judicial District Court with various responsibilities, such as supervising the administrative business of the court, ensuring the quality and continuity of its services, supervising its calendar, reassigning cases as convenience or necessity requires, assuring the court’s duties are timely and orderly performed, and otherwise facilitating the business of the court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Department 2 shall replace Department 15 in Track 8 of the Criminal Case Flow Model.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that an updated Criminal Case Flow Model shall be attached to this order as “Exhibit 1.”

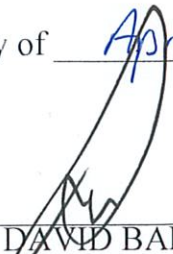
