WHEREAS elections are being held in Clark County, Nevada on June 14, 2016 ("Primary Election Day") and November 8, 2016 ("General Election Day");

WHEREAS Rule 1.30 of the Rules of Practice for the Eighth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada ("EDCR") charges the Chief Judge of the Eighth Judicial District Court ("Court") with various responsibilities, such as supervising the administrative business of the Court, ensuring the quality and continuity of its services, supervising its calendar, reassigning cases as convenience or necessity requires, assuring the Court's duties are timely and orderly performed, and otherwise facilitating business of the the Court:

WHEREAS the Court, by this order, intends to prepare for the possibility that actions pertaining to the election process may be filed during or after regular business hours and further intends to implement a fair and expeditious process by which election-related actions can be heard and adjudicated through the end of Primary Election Day and General Election Day;

WHEREAS the Court deems it in the best interests of justice to extend its hours of operation and to designate four judges within the Eighth Judicial District Court to serve on Primary Election Day and General Election Day in order to help ensure the fair and expeditious resolution of all election-related actions filed on Primary Election Day or General Election Day.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(b)(12) and EDCR 1.30(b)(14), that, concurrently with and in addition to its regular business hours, the Clerk's Office shall be open to the public between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. both on Primary Election Day and General Election Day for the purpose of processing the filing of election-related actions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(b)(14), EDCR 1.30(b)(15) and EDCR 1.60(a), that the district judges in Departments 2, 11, 24 and 26 will serve as the designated Primary Election Day and General Election Day judges to individually preside, on a randomly-generated rotational basis, over any and all election-related actions filed beginning at 7:00 a.m. and ending at 12:00 a.m. on Primary Election Day and beginning at 7:00 a.m. and ending at 12:00 a.m. on General Election Day.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(b)(12) and EDCR 1.30(b)(14) that each election-related action shall be randomly assigned to Department 2, 11, 24, or 26, and that each department receiving such a random assignment shall be excluded from subsequent assignments until all four departments have drawn an election-related action, at which time the random assignment process shall begin anew.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(b)(12) and EDCR 1.30(b)(14), that the Clerk's Office shall take the steps reasonably necessary to preserve the integrity of the aforementioned assignment process and that at least two representatives from court staff shall witness each random drawing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(b)(12) and EDCR 1.30(b)(14) that the Clerk's Office shall accept in-person, paper-filing of all election-related actions beginning at 7:00 a.m. and ending at 9:00 p.m. on Primary Election Day and General Election Day; the Court encourages litigants intending to file election-related actions between these hours to do so in person and to include the term "Election-Related Action" in the caption of the pleading so as to help assure the proper designation of their filing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the term "Election-Related Action" shall be construed liberally to include all matters touching upon the facilitation and integrity of the 2016 Primary and General Elections.
