ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF MISDEMEANOR APPEALS

WHEREAS, the Eighth Judicial District Court entered an ADMINISTRATIVE

ORDER REGARDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF MISDEMEANOR APPEALS FROM

MUNICIPAL COURTS, No. 09-10, on August 13, 2009. This administrative order designated a judge in the civil criminal division for assignment of all misdemeanor appeals from municipal courts.

WHEREAS, the intention of the Administrative Order filed on August 13, 2009 was to end the rotation of misdemeanor appeals from both municipal courts and from justice courts. This Administrative Order No. 09-15 confirms that misdemeanor appeals from both municipal courts and from justice courts shall be heard by a designated judge in the civil criminal division for as long as the chief judge determines that the interests of the district court are promoted by the use of one docket assignment for these cases.

WHEREAS, the Eighth Judicial District Court Rule 1.30 (b)(5) provides that the chief judge make regular and special assignments of all judges, and hear or reassign emergency matters when a judge is absent or otherwise unavailable.

WHEREAS, the Eighth Judicial District Court Rule 1.30 (b)(18) provides that the chief judge assure that court duties are timely and orderly performed.

WHEREAS, the Eighth Judicial District Court Rule 1.30 (b)(18)(iv) provides, in part, that to facilitate the business of the court, the chief judge may delegate the duties prescribed in these rules to other judges.

WHEREAS, the assignment of all misdemeanor appeals to be heard by one district judge in the civil criminal division is an efficient management decision for the court and the court's justice partners. The chief judge and the judges of the Eighth Judicial District Court have determined that the rotation of the hearing of misdemeanor appeals from both municipal courts and from justice courts on a monthly basis has not been an effective allocation of judicial resources.

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee and the judges of the Eighth Judicial District Court approved a change in EDCR 1.64 that eliminated the rotation of the hearing of misdemeanor appeals. Nevada Supreme Court approved the elimination of the rotation of the hearing of misdemeanor appeals in its Order Amending Eighth Judicial District Court Rules on November 10, 2009, in ADKT 418.

Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Honorable Donald M. Mosley, District Court,

Department 14, shall hear all misdemeanor appeals pursuant to this administrative order for the

Eighth Judicial District Court.
