## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF DISCOVERY MATTERS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in addition to the assignments stated in Administrative Order 2010-03, Commissioner Chris Beecroft shall be assigned to hear discovery matters filed in the following judicial departments: 28 and 31.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that discovery matters in the business court division will be heard by the respective business court judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order shall be in effect on January 1, 2011, and shall continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent Administrative Order.
