## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING BUSINESS COURT

WHEREAS, the Eighth Judicial District Court Rule 1.33 (b) provides that the Chief Judge must assign Judges of the District to the Business Court Division.

WHEREAS, the Eighth Judicial District Court Rule 1.61 provides for the assignment of Business Matters.

WHEREAS, Judge Kathleen Delaney has been reassigned to Specialty Courts, which require amendment to Administrative Orders 09-09 and 06-06.

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge and the Executive Committee of the Eighth Judicial District Court has selected Judge Susan Scann as the third Business Court Judge, joining Judge Elizabeth Gonzalez and Judge Mark Denton as the District Judges to hear Business Court matters pursuant to EDCR 1.33 and EDCR 1.61.

Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Honorable Susan Scann, Department XXIX, is hereby designated to serve as a Business Court Judge for the Eighth Judicial District Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Honorable Elizabeth Gonzalez, Department XI, the Honorable Judge Mark Denton, Department XIII and Honorable Susan Scann, Department XXIX, shall be the three District Judges assigned Business Court matters for the Eighth Judicial District Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, along with Judge Allan R Earl, Department XIX, Judge Nancy L Allf, Department XXVII, has been selected to act as a Conflict Business Court Judge in those instances where the other Judges have been peremptorily challenged or otherwise recuses.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the new business court filings effective June 27, 2011 or after shall be assigned randomly, ½ to Department XI, ¼ to Department XIII and ¼ to Department XXIX to hear the Business Court docket. If one of the Business Court Judges named above is peremptorily challenged or otherwise recuses, the case shall be assigned to one of the other Business Court Judges. In those instances where all of the Business Court Judges have been peremptorily challenged or otherwise recuses, then the case shall be assigned to the Judge(s) assigned to preside over Business Court cases on a Conflict Basis. In those instances where all such Judges have been peremptorily challenged or otherwise recuses, then the case shall be assigned to the Chief Judge of the District Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order shall be in effect on June 27, 2011, and shall continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent Administrative Order.
