WHEREAS the Eighth Judicial District Court expects two new judicial appointees to assume case adjudication in the Civil/Criminal Division by no later than August 6, 2012; and,

WHEREAS redistribution of the existing cases in the Eighth Judicial District Court Civil/Criminal Division is required to ensure equitable caseloads among all its judges; and,

WHEREAS equitable caseload distribution fosters greater efficiency toward the timely adjudication of cases in the Civil/Criminal Division:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Department 25's current entire open criminal caseload and current entire open specialty caseload shall be transferred to Department 7.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Department 7's current entire open criminal caseload shall be transferred to Department 9.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Department 7's current entire open civil caseload be transferred as follows: 250 cases to Department 25 and the remainder to Department 14.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Department 14's current entire open criminal and civil caseloads, with the exception of municipal court appeals, shall be transferred to Department 25.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that 325 cases aged 48 months or less from Department 26's current open civil caseload shall be transferred to Department 14.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that 325 cases aged 48 months or less from Department 27's current open civil caseload shall be transferred to Department 14.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that 325 cases aged 48 months or less from Department 31's current open civil caseload be transferred to Department 14.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that 75 cases from Department 13's current open civil caseload, excluding business court cases, shall be transferred to Department 14.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that 75 cases from Department 29's current open civil caseload, excluding business court cases, shall be transferred to Department 14.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that 100 cases from Department 32's current open civil caseload, excluding foreclosure mediation petitions for judicial review, shall be transferred to Department 4.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the aforementioned transfers shall take effect on August 6, 2012.
