Opportunity for Probation with Enforcement in Nevada (OPEN)

Purpose:

The Opportunity for Probation with Enforcement in Nevada (OPEN) Court provides intensive behavioral modification programming to participants in the hope to decrease their criminal behaviors. The OPEN Court attempts to reintegrate participants into the community, assessing their individual needs and connecting them with the appropriate community-based resources, while working to address their court requirements simultaneously. The program offers random drug/alcohol testing, court supervision of program compliance, and access to various groups and services.

Treatment Includes:

- Regular random drug testing (urine tests),
- Limited outpatient services,
- Collaborative case management,
- Community supervision,
- Referrals to sober living, low income housing, and/or temporary/transitional housing,
- Electronic monitoring device,
- Electronic alcohol use monitoring,¹ and
- Regular court status check reviews.

Eligibility:

- Males and Females
- 18 to 26 years of age at time of application,
- Minimum of 16 months remaining on Probation,
- No sex offenders,
- Limited medical issues or concerns, unable to dispense medications,
- Limited mental health issues or concerns, will be staffed on a case by case basis,
- Identified alcohol/substance abuse disorders, will be staffed on a case by case basis,
- Gang affiliation or members, will be staffed on a case by case basis, and
- Violent offenses will be staffed on a case by case basis.

Cost: Each participant is required to pay Court Fee of \$1,500.00. The program costs for treatment and testing are paid by the Court. Ancillary services or sanctions may require additional fees to be paid by participant.

Length: The program length is a minimum of 12 months, subject to participation and compliance.
