



## **EIGHTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT VETERANS TREATMENT COURT**

*Presiding Judge:* Honorable Judge Bitá Yeager

*Hearing Dates:* The first and third Tuesday of the month (additional dates may be added), @ 12:30p, Courtroom 14C.

### **Purpose:**

The Veteran's Treatment Court serves U.S. Military Veterans involved in the criminal justice system who suffer from service-related substance abuse and/or mental health issues by providing treatment for these behavioral health issues.

### **Treatment includes:**

- Regular random drug testing (urine tests),
- Individual and group substance abuse and mental health counseling,
- Trauma focused therapies, cognitive behavioral therapy, and wellness education.
- Vocational education and guidance.
- Collaborative case management.
- Regular court reviews.

### **Eligibility:**

- Applicants must be veterans or members of the U.S. Military.
- Applicants must not have a Dishonorable military discharge.
- Applicants must have a service-related substance abuse or mental health issue.
- Applicants do not have a Category A felony offense or a sexual offense that is punishable as a Category B felony.

*Cost:* \$1,500.

*Length:* Minimum program length is 18 months.
